You have heard me say this many times over the years. I do live by this belief: God gives me what I need, not necessarily what I want. Although, I confess, that the Lord, more often than not, gives me what I want in great abundance.

I learned this lesson from St. Teresa of Calcutta. Mother trusted completely in God's providence, His loving care. She taught the Sisters and many others the same lesson.

There was a convent in a very poor country. The Sisters contacted Mother to tell her that their pantry was empty and they had no money. Mother Teresa told the Sisters to make a list of everything they needed and to tie the list to the base of their statue of St. Joseph. She instructed them to pray and to trust in God's providence. By the end of the day, the Sisters had everything on their list.

There are many other similar anecdotes in the history of the Missionaries of Charity.

The Lord Jesus has time and again provided for me. As I age, I trust more and more in Him.

I take the same approach with the administration of the parish. If God wills something, it will happen. If He does not will it, why should we want or need it?

You certainly are instruments of that providence and I am grateful for your kindness and generosity. I am overwhelmed each year at Christmas time with the gifts and your kind words.

I am, as you know too well, horrible when it comes to written acknowledgements of these thoughtful gifts. I am getting a little better at it, but have a long way to go.

Be assured of my gratitude, despite my deficiencies.
