Centennial News: The Archbishop of New Orleans asked the French Jesuits to come to Louisiana in 1836 to establish a school for boys in Grand Coteau. The Religious of the Sacred Heart had already established a school for girls in Grand Coteau. Archbishop Blanc of New Orleans laid the cornerstone for the school on July 31, 1837. Named St. Charles College, the place became the Jesuit Spirituality Center in 1972. The Jesuits are still active in the diocese.
