**Quelques paroles de Monsieur le Cure**

It will be the month of November by the time you read this.

The month begins with the Solemnity of All Saints, celebrating the memory of those outstanding men and women who have gone before us and intercede for us constantly in heaven.

The solemnity of All Saints gives way the very next day to our somber commemoration of all the faithful departed, All Souls Day. This is the day when we visit the cemeteries where our beloved dead are buried. On a cultural note, people of Acadian ancestry visit their cemeteries on the afternoon of All Saints, in keeping with the Gallican Rite to which our ancestors belonged. The Masses of All Souls Day remind us to support in prayer those awaiting the final purification. We know, too, that the souls of those awaiting heaven also intercede for us.

The first two days of November invite us to renew our appreciation of the fullness of the Church: those in heaven, those awaiting heaven, and those of us on earth. The bonds of faith, created in the waters of baptism, unite us for all eternity.

This is not history in the sense of recalling past events, this is a living, dynamic Great Tradition, the Church.

I cannot imagine my life apart from the Church because she has always been my life. As soon as I was able, I began waking up in the early morning unassisted and attending Mass. Daily Mass has been consistently a part of my life since then. Even when I am on vacation I make an effort either to celebrate Mass daily or at least to attend Mass.

At the same time, I readily acknowledge my sinfulness. It has never been a question of God's grace lacking in my life, but of my hardness of heart that resists that overwhelming grace. My earliest teachers, however, taught me to entrust myself to the mercy and compassion of the Lord Jesus, which I continue to do to this very day.

I do not strive for perfection, but only for fidelity to Him Who has always been faithful to me, even when, or perhaps especially when, I do not deserve His love.

November reminds me that countless men and women have experienced the same struggles, entertained the same doubts, and been plagued by their personal weaknesses and sinfulness. They were saved by the grace of Christ. Others are awaiting that fullness of salvation. I want to be with them some day. It is a well-founded hope in Christ Jesus.
